Meetings of the Burgh Parish Council are held on the first Wednesday of each month in Burgh Village Hall, starting at 7.30pm.

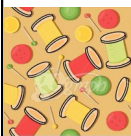

Work will continue to be on-going to re-advertise and take things on from here, and there is every reason to be optimistic that there will be a good outcome ahead of us, even if at present we do not know exactly when that will be. We all hope and pray that the right candidate will feel called to apply and be appointed and there will be further updates in your Parish Magazine as we work towards that aim.

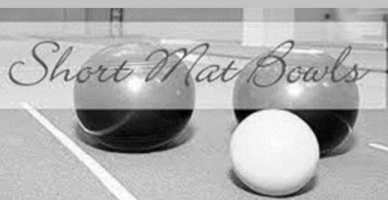

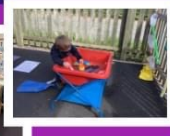
